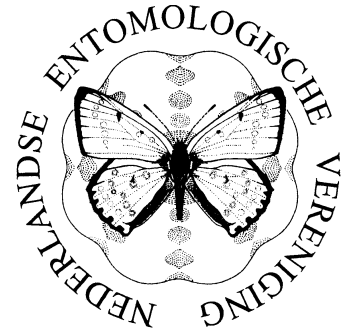




NEV Dissertation Award



Each year, the Nederlandse Entomologische Vereniging [NEV; Dutch Entomological Society] offers a Dissertation Award, for the best dissertation in the field of Entomology, based on its scientific quality.

The award amounts to 1000 Euro and is handed out by the chairperson of the NEV at the 'Nederlandse Entomologendag', that takes place on every 3rd Friday in December.

The laureate is expected to present his/her work in a plenary lecture during the *Entomologendag*, as well as in a written contribution to the Society's journal *Entomologische Berichten*.

Eligible for the award are dissertations that have been defended successfully during the *preceding* academic year (running from 1 September to 31 July) at one of the Dutch universities. The award is only offered if there are three or more contestants.

Selection is done by the board members of the NEV's Sectie Experimentele en Toegepaste Entomologie [SETE; section Experimental and Applied Entomology] (if necessary, supplemented with one or two taxonomical and/or faunistical entomologists) in its autumn meeting. The three best dissertations are forwarded to the society's main board, that shall decide on the laureate in its November meeting.

Young doctors who would like to take part in the competition should submit **in 8-fold** a concise description of their research (not more than 1 page A4), a curriculum vitae, and a copy of the dissertation, **before 1 August**, to SETE's secretary:
